Salt & Light


(We Are To Be)

Matthew 5:13 (New International Version)

13 "You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot.

Why?

Matthew 5:27-28 (King James Version)

27Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not commit adultery: 28But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

Matthew 5:21-22 (New Living Translation)

"You have heard that our ancestors were told, 'You must not murder. If you commit murder, you are subject to judgment.' 22 But I say, if you are even angry with someone, you are subject to judgment! If you call someone an idiot, you are in danger of being brought before the court. And if you curse someone, you are in danger of the fires of hell.

Notice that JESUS taught it is far better to "nip in the bud" such thoughts as jealousy, anger, & lust, than to allow the possibility of these thoughts to grow into action. At your core you should strive to be the best you,... that you can be. Pray to GOD for the strength to help you control negative thoughts or emotions. It is perhaps one of the hardest things that any of us will ever learn to do. We all have these thoughts and desires, just depend on the HOLY SPIRIT to teach you, to react quickly inside to suppress those feelings.

Mark 7:21-23 (New International Version)

He went on: "What comes out of a person is what defiles them. 21 For it is from within, out of a person's heart, that evil thoughts come—sexual immorality, theft, murder, 22 adultery, greed, malice, deceit, lewdness, envy, slander, arrogance and folly.


23 All these evils come from inside and defile a person."
